

# Request

For the sake of patients receiving blood donations, please engage in "Responsible blood donation."

Do not donate blood for the purpose of testing for AIDS or other infections.

Please complete the questionnaire accurately before donating blood.

## The following individuals cannot donate blood

- ✓ Those who have undergone dental treatment involving bleeding (extraction, scaling, etc.) **within the past three days**
- ✓ Those who have returned (entered) from overseas **within the past four weeks**
- ✓ Those who have had a piercing done **within the past month**
- ✓ Those whose purpose is to test for AIDS
- ✓ Those who have had any of the following **within the past six months**:
  - (a) Sexual contact with an unspecified number of partners or a new partner
  - (b) Sexual contact between men
  - (c) Use of narcotics or stimulants
  - (d) Sexual contact with anyone who falls into the above categories
- ✓ Those who have ever had any of the following:
  - (a) Blood transfusion (excluding autologous blood) or organ transplant
  - (b) Use of human-derived placenta injections
  - (c) Contracted syphilis, hepatitis C, malaria, or Chagas disease
- ✓ You fall under any of the following categories and have not yet left Central or South America (excluding Mexico and the Caribbean) **for more than six months** (if more than six months have passed, please inform a member of staff):
  - You were born or raised in Central or South America
  - Your mother or maternal grandmother was born or raised in Central or South America
  - You have stayed or resided in Central or South America for more than four consecutive weeks
- ✓ Those diagnosed with Zika virus infection (Zika fever) who have not yet passed one month after recovery

## If any of the following apply to you, please inform the staff

- ✓ Those who have taken or used medication within the **past three days**
- ✓ Those who have received a vaccination **within the past year**
- ✓ Overseas living history
  - Those who have stayed in a foreign country (excluding Europe, the USA, and Canada) within the past three years.
  - Those who have stayed in Europe or Saudi Arabia for more than one month since 1980

Even if you do not fall into any of the above categories, you may still be refused from donating blood based on the questionnaire responses.
